



HEALTH AIDE SERVICES

Covered Health Aide School Based Services

Health Aides are also referred to as paraprofessionals, teacher aides, one-on-one assistants, personal care aides, and instructional aides. Services documented in the student's IEP/IFSP, provide assistance with activities of daily living and are necessitated by the student's medical condition can be submitted to Medicaid.

These services include, but are not limited to:

1. Transferring and ambulating
2. Assistance with food, nutrition, and diet activities
3. Bowel and bladder care
4. Redirection and intervention for medically-related behavior (non-discipline related)

Health Aide Provider Qualifications

School Health Aide services are provided by staff who have been trained and remain under the direction of skilled professional medical personnel. The Health Aide supervisor must co-sign documentation of all services provided by practitioners under his or her direction.

General Service Requirements

- Billable Health Aide services must be outlined in the students Individualized Education Plan (IEP) any must specify scope, frequency, and duration that correlate with the professional recommendations.
